

Young Trustee Nomination Committee Revision

Old vs. New process

Old process

1. YTNC is made up of ICC members
2. YTNC reads applications down to top 8
3. YTNC interviews applications down to top 3
4. YTNC and DSG together vote on 1 selection

New Process

1. ICC and DSG each select 10 electors to make up YTNC for total of 20 members
 - a. Any ICC member who runs for the position of Young Trustee is ineligible to be on the YTNC
 - i. The member chosen as a replacement must be the president, vice-president, or second in line
 - b. If the ICC does not have 10 qualified candidates, the total number on the YTNC decreases to twice the number of ICC members of the YTNC
 - c. If the ICC does not have 7 members qualified for the YTNC, DSG may select members to maintain a total committee membership of 14
 - d. The ICC submissions are chosen by a vote of the ICC.
 - i. Anyone interested in running for YTNC as an ICC representative must be elected by the ICC directly
 - ii. Any member chosen by the ICC that does not regularly represent the organization on the ICC must be approved by the DSG Judiciary
2. YTNC reads applications down to 8
3. YTNC interviews applications down to 3
3. Weighted ICC and DSG vote on final three candidates
 - a. All of ICC would be included, even the previously organizations whom forfeited their votes
 - b. All of DSG Senators would vote just like current process
