

A STATUTE OF THE DUKE STUDENT GOVERNMENT
Concerning a referendum on revisions to the Duke Community Standard

Policy Statement

The Duke Student Government (DSG) authorizes a referendum of the student body to be held on the following changes to the Duke Community Standard during the spring 2007 semester. The exact timing of the referendum may be left to the discretion of the Executive Committee and the Attorney General. Specifically, DSG authorizes the following language to be included as the referendum question:

Do you support revising the Duke Community Standard to read as follows?

“Duke University is a community dedicated to scholarship, leadership, and service, and to the principles of honesty, openness, fairness, and accountability. Citizens of this community commit to reflect upon and uphold these principles in all academic and non-academic endeavors and to protect and promote a culture of integrity.

To uphold the Duke Community Standard and the policies derived from it:

- I will not lie, cheat, or steal in my academic endeavors.
- I will conduct myself honorably in all my endeavors.
- I will act when the Standard is compromised.”
